Qualifications/Requirements: CITI certification and 3.5+ G.P.A; must have knowledge of and ability to use statistical tools like SPSS, SAS, and R; demonstrated knowledge of Microsoft Office Suite; excellent time management, communication, and interpersonal skills; and ability to work with a wide range of individuals with diverse backgrounds and perspectives on data usage.

Major: Statistics, Mathematics, Educational Statistics, Evaluation and Measurement, or related major with coursework in applied social sciences, quantitative methods, measure and assessment, or statistics.
